WEEKLY “*PRESENT*” REVIEW

Description of Didactic Activity:

This didactic activity resource shall include direct participation of the resident to become professionally inquisitive, life-long learners and teachers utilizing research, scholarly activity, and information technologies to enhance professional knowledge and clinical practice. The program shall provide the “*Present*” coursework for the residents. All residents will review the weekly addition of “Present” as per the year of training as distributed.
