COMPETENCY FOR **PODIATRIC MEDICINE** ROTATION

Competencies: The resident will be able to demonstrate an understanding of and competency in the following areas:

1. Resident demonstrates appropriate competence in the evaluation and medical management of patients with a variety of lower extremity musculo-skeletal diseases, conditions and deformities in inpatient and outpatient settings.

2. Resident demonstrates competence in:
 - A. Performing problem focused history and physical exams.
 - B. Biomechanical evaluation
 - C. Formulating appropriate differential diagnoses and working diagnosis.

3. Resident demonstrates competence in:
 - A. Interpreting various diagnostic studies
 - B. Knowledge of indications, contraindications of treatment
 - C. Potential complications and appropriate follow up management.

4. Resident demonstrates competence in:
 - A. the evaluation and management of acute trauma cases
 - B. Podopediatric cases
 - C. Biomechanical cases including understanding the techniques and interpretations of gait evaluations of neurologic and pathomechanical disorders

5. Resident demonstrates ability to provide podiatric services in a variety of healthcare settings.
